Planning Ahead

2023 World Evangelism Media & Missions Guyana Workshops

It is necessary to plan ahead to arrange the several logistics required to conduct a series of countrywide workshops annually throughout Guyana, South America. Funds need to be received in advance of scheduling international travel between North America and South America for Martha and me, as well as for our team of four (including the two of us): travel by small plane, boats, cars and minibuses within Guyana; lodging from place to place in country; and meals. In addition, we feed the combined hundreds of brethren who attend the workshops and offset travel expenses of some attendees (e.g., bridge tolls, taxi or bus fees and boat fuel). Last year, this program, lasting six weeks and visiting nine of the ten regions (including our travel be-



tween the USA and Guyana) cost about \$27,000. In 2022, the mobile workshops extended from the last few days of January, all of February and two weeks into March.

Ideally, we need to put money into the hands of our counterparts in Guyana – coworkers and brothers in Christ – beginning in December so they can buy plane tickets and make lodging reservations. Given the cost of this program, we would like to encourage you – individual Christians and congregations of the churches of Christ – to begin sending monetary gifts now – designating on the memo line "Guyana Workshops." It's not too early or too soon to send your gift now for the 2023 World Evangelism Media & Missions Guyana Workshops. This program edifies fellow Christians overseas and helps them edify themselves and evangelize their own country.

Shipping Bibles & Christian Literature

Martha and I continue to make at least two shipments annually of Bibles and Christian literature to Guyana. A shipment is in transit now (about a month-long), which contains 8 boxes of Large Print Bibles, 1 case of *Panoramic Views of the Bible* (40 copies), 1 case of *Church of Bible* (100+ copies), 40 boxes (35 copies each) of *The Voice of Truth International*, Volume 110 and 51 boxes of *The Voice of Truth International*, Volume 111 and a few boxes of *The Voice of Truth International*, Volumes 74 and 70. In addition, we have newly put in place the shipment of 3,000 copies of each new edition of *The Voice of Truth International* from the printers in India. Our Guyanese brethren use or otherwise distribute **all** of the tracts and *The Voice of Truth International* that we can supply to them. Coworkers in World Evangelism, Jerry and Paula Bates, graciously haul ship-

ments from our warehouse in Winona, Mississippi to Nashville, Tennessee and pack them for their journey by land to Miami, Florida, where they are loaded onto container ships.

Foreign Television Programs

We continue to facilitate funds for two foreign television programs. The more expensive of the two is a Hindi language broadcast from New Delhi, India. Brothers Sunny David, Francis David and Vinay David are the speakers. The program continues to receive immediate responses after each airing, to which literature and personal Bible studies address inquiries about Christianity. Most people in India are Hindus. Currently, this program costs \$17,500 annually for one 30-minute broadcast weekly. (A second airing weekly occurs through funds obtained and facilitated by another World Evangelism team member.) Thousands of additional dollars permit the printing and mailing of Christian literature to persons responding to the TV program.


We also facilitate funds for a foreign television program in the English language from Georgetown, Guyana (South America). English is the official language of Guyana, and the country is the only English-speaking nation in South America. The indigenous tribes, referred to as the Amerindians, also speak their local languages in the absence of Eng-

lish speakers. Presently, the second New Delhi program and the Georgetown program are being funded through the aspect of World Evangelism associated with the late J.C. Choate and his widow, Betty Choate. Martha and I follow up with literature for distribution and annual workshops throughout Guyana.

Books & Tracts



At this time, Preaching the Whole Counsel of God to the Whole World, Vol. 5, is being printed. It is expected to be ready for shipment and distribution in early November 2022. There are six volumes of full-sentence sermon outlines in all; volume six will be printed in 2023. This series represents nearly 50 years of my preaching. They are designed to provide anyone the crux of each subject discussed with ample scriptural references. Volumes of this series already in print have been shipped abroad with the aim of assisting brethren who may have less resources available to them; Volume 1 has been or is being translated into three of the primary languages of India.

Also coming in 2023 is Our Restoration Heritage, containing hundreds of years of religious and secular history in chronological format, with an emphasis on a return to the Bible as the standard for the practice of Christianity. Several other writers have contributed chapters on various aspects of Restoration History.

The Voice of Truth International & Gospel Gazette Online

It is my pleasure to serve as the Editor of two Gospel magazines. The Voice of Truth International is a printed magazine consisting of 116 pages from cover to cover. We print about 60,000 copies quarterly, mostly in the English language but also in several foreign languages, too. We don't distribute any to Antarctica, but The Voice of Truth International goes to several countries on the other continents.

Gospel Gazette Online (www.GospelGazette.com) is a 16-page, monthly Internet magazine that circulates worldwide and is also available at no cost to the user even without a subscription. The "Digital Library" at Gospel Gazette Online provides free access to all past editions of The Voice of Truth International and about three dozen books and tracts, all in downloadable PDF files. The "Archive" at GGO preserves thousands of articles on a myriad of topics and is accessible by an onsite search engine, by selecting an edition or by selecting from the index.

Both magazines are populated with articles by faithful brothers and sisters in Christ. It takes about a quarter to prepare each issue of *The Voice of Truth International* and about a month to prepare each edition of Gospel Gazette Online. You can imagine that these magazines and other activities to which we devote ourselves (mentioned above) give us purpose in our lives daily.
